We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Decision 2005/848/EC of 29 November 2005 implementing Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 on specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities with a view to combating terrorism and repealing Decision 2005/722/EC.

Through this Decision, the Council adopted an updated list of groups and entities to whom Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 applies.

This Decision takes effect on the day of its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 314, pages 46-47 of 30 November 2005.

Following the repeal of Decision 2005/722/EC, circular CSSF 05/214 of 18 October 2005 is also repealed.

We remind you that you are required to immediately report any relevant information relating to this Decision to the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier, which will forward the information to the Division of International Economic Relations of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration, as well as to the Ministry of Finance.
