Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to draw you attention to the decision taken by the Financial Action Task Force (FATF) at its plenary meeting held on 9-13 October 2006 to remove Myanmar from the list of countries and territories considered non-cooperative (NCCTs), following the country's efforts to implement its anti-money laundering system. FATF will continue to monitor Myanmar to ensure it makes further progress.

Following the removal of Myanmar from the NCCT list, no country is on this list any more. Hence, please note that circulars CSSF 05/212 and 06/250 are repealed and that points 73 to 76 of circular CSSF 05/211 of 13 October 2005 have become purposeless.
