Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to draw your attention to Commission Regulation (EC) No 1033/2009 of 28 October 2009 amending for the 115th time Council Regulation (EC) No 881/2002 imposing certain specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities associated with Usama bin Laden, the Al-Qaida network and the Taliban.

The purpose of this new Regulation is to remove four entries from the list of legal persons, groups and entities to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply and which is included in Annex I to Regulation (EC) No 881/2002.

Regulation (EC) No 1033/2009 shall enter into force on the day following its publication in the Official Journal of the European Union No L 283, pages 51-52, of 30 October 2009.

It is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.
