**Re: Combating terrorism**

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Council Implementing Regulation (EU) No 610/2010 of 12 July 2010 implementing Article 2(3) of Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 on specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities with a view to combating terrorism and repealing Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1285/2009.

By means of this Regulation, the Council decided to withdraw two entries from the list of persons, groups and entities to which the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply as laid down in Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001: **Kahane Chai (a.k.a. Kach)** and **Palestine Liberation Front – (PLF)**.

The Regulation entered into force on the day of its publication in the [Official Journal of the European Union No L 178](#), pages 1-4, of 13 July 2010.

Owing to the repeal of Implementing Regulation (EU) No 1285/2009, Circular CSSF 09/429 is repealed as well.

We also draw your attention to two notices issued for the attention of the persons, groups and entities included in the list provided for in Article 2(3) of Council Regulation (EC) No 2580/2001 on specific restrictive measures directed against certain persons and entities with a view to combating terrorism.
