**Re:** restrictive measures in relation to the persons indicted by the ICTY

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 416/2006 of 10 March 2006 amending, for the ninth time, Council Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004 imposing certain restrictive measures in support of effective implementation of the mandate of the International Criminal Tribunal for the former Yugoslavia (ICTY).

According to this new Regulation, the name of the following person is removed from Annexe I to Regulation (EC) No 1763/2004, which lists the persons to whom the freezing of funds and economic resources should apply: Milan LUKIC.

Regulation (EC) No 416/2006 is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States. The Regulation entered into force on the day following its publication in the [Official Journal of the European Union No L 72, page 7](#) of 11 March 2006.
