Re: restrictive measures in respect of Zimbabwe

Ladies and Gentlemen,

We are pleased to inform you of the publication of Commission Regulation (EC) No 777/2007 of 2 July 2007 amending Council Regulation (EC) No 314/2004 concerning certain restrictive measures in respect of Zimbabwe.

The purpose of this Regulation is to replace Annexe III to Regulation (EC) No 314/2004 which lists the persons covered by the freezing of funds and economic resources under that Regulation. The amendment comes with Council Decision 2007/455/CFSP of 30 June 2007 implementing Common Position 2004/161/CFSP renewing restrictive measures against Zimbabwe.

Regulation (EC) No 777/2007 entered into force on the day of its publication in the [Official Journal of the European Union No L 173, pages 3-15](#), of 3 July 2007. It is binding in its entirety and directly applicable in all Member States.

Please report immediately any relevant information relating to this Regulation to the Commission de Surveillance du Secteur Financier, which will forward the information to the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and Immigration, Division of International Economic Relations, as well as to the Ministry of Finance.
