

Administrative fine imposed under article 25(2) of the Transparency Law on 22 November 2017

The CSSF, as competent authority to ensure that the provisions of the law of 11 January 2008 on transparency requirements for issuers (the “Transparency Law”) are applied, has decided to impose an administrative fine on Malta Freeport Corporation Limited pursuant to article 25(2) of the Transparency Law on 22 November 2017. Malta Freeport Corporation Limited, as issuer of securities whose home Member State for the purposes of the Transparency Law is Luxembourg, has failed to publish its half-yearly financial report as of 30 June 2017 within the required time limit.

The administrative fine amounts to EUR 5,000.

According to article 27 of the Transparency Law, a court action against this decision may be lodged by the issuer with the “Tribunal administratif” (Administrative Court) within three months.

The CSSF publishes this administrative fine in accordance with article 22(2)(g) of the Transparency Law.
